3. House Chamber, also used for joint sessions of Congress.
4. The sandstone West Front is surrounded by flowers.
5. Statue of Chief Justice John Marshall at the West Front
6. Subway connects Capitol with Senate office buildings.
7. Old Senate Chamber, used by Supreme Court from 1860-1935.

View-Master Reel Three

1. Senate Committee on Foreign Relations Room.
2. President's Room used for signing lame duck bills.
3. Ceiling of the President's Room also has Brumidi frescoes.
4. Vice President's office in Senate wing.
5. The Senate Reception Room, another Brumidi design.
6. The painting "Battle of Lake Erie," hangs in the stairway of the Capitol.
7. A symbol of our country the Capitol Dome, lighted at night

View-Master Reel One

1. The Capitol, designed 1792, was rebuilt after the War of 1812.
2. Capitol Hill and surrounding buildings.
3. The 287-foot-high Capitol Dome, tallest building in the city.
4. The Capitol Rotunda, containing paintings of historic events.
5. Fresco on Rotunda ceiling was painted by Brumidi, an Italian immigrant.
6. The cellar crypt was designed as tomb for George Washington.
7. Statuary Hall was used as House Chamber until 1857.

View-Master Reel Two

1. House Reception Room, one of 102 rooms added in 1960.
2. Formal office of Speaker of the House.
